

Dear Customers,

Please be informed, that according to the Order of the President of the National Bank of Georgia the format of your account will be changed to IBAN (International Bank Account Number) format starting **May 3, 2010**.

For Georgia, the IBAN account number consists of 22 (twenty two) characters. It will have the following structure:

GE KK BB CC CCCC CCCC CCCC CC

GE – The code denoting Georgia;

KK – A control key (the Hindu-Arabic numerals);

BB – A Georgian bank code (upper case Latin alphabetic characters 'A to Z'). The Code of HSBC Bank Georgia is **HG**;

C – The combination of the Hindu-Arabic numerals given by a bank to an account (16 digits).

The IBAN format of "HSBC Bank Georgia" is the following: **GE66HG0000001006600001**
